The Fieldstone Experience

We strongly believe that academic success and a positive homestay experience are interconnected. That's why everyone in the Fieldstone community – the student, homestay families, teachers, international student coordinators, guidance, administrators and homeland parents/guardians – has an active role to ensure our students are happy, healthy and successful.

FHS Families

Homestay families are expected to provide a nurturing and supportive home environment to international students residing with them. They are to integrate the student in the household by participating in shared activities together such as shopping, visiting local sites and conversing on a daily basis. They are also expected to attend school events, monitoring attendance and health issues if arise.



In terms of accommodations, Fieldstone Homestay Families are expected to provide students with:

- A private furnished room with study area
- Linens and towels
- Three meals a day
- Access to laundry facilities including detergent
- Telephone access for local calls
- Television and high-speed Internet

Living with a homestay family provides many added values to international students, such as improving their English language fluency and understanding of the Canadian culture and social values through daily interaction with homestay family members. An immersion experience that one will not otherwise obtain in classroom settings.



Objectives

- Delivering a homestay program that fosters personal, social and emotional stability and cultural understanding
- Providing mentorship through a streamlined support network of school, homestay family, and homeland parents
- Cultivating leadership, social and cultural adjustment skills through orientation, workshops, seminars and extra-curricular events
