**Math** – In Math, this week we worked in our very own Math Booklets. The booklet had lots of different math activities which helped us to consolidate our learning from the year. We also played some math games.

**Science** – In Science, this week we conducted an experiment. We put some white flowers into two different vases. One vase had clear water in it, and the other vase had coloured water in it. The students had to predict what they thought would happen to each of the flowers in the different vases.

**English** – This week in English, we have been doing lots of writing about our favourite things in Kindergarten. We have also been sharing our writing with the class.

**Social Studies** – In Social Studies, we learned about South American rainforests and also Toucans. We learned that the Amazon rainforest is the largest tropical rainforest in the world. We also learned that the cougar, jaguar, and anaconda all live in the Amazon rainforest. We

learned that Toucans have a black body and white throat, and a colourful giant beak! Toucans get most of their water from the fruit they eat, so they don't need to drink too much water. Next week we will be learning about our very last continent and country, Australia.

**Gym** – In Gym, this week we played some of our favourite games that we have learned throughout the year. We all chose a few games that we enjoyed, and then voted on our favourite ones. Fun was had by all.
