We had a marvellous week at school this week. On Wednesday afternoon we had our final assembly of the year. As we are nearing the end of the school year, we are also busy finishing off all of our units of learning.

Math – In Math, this week we continued our unit on Measurement. Previously, we learned about length and weight. This week we learned about capacity and how much a container can hold. We measured different containers and put them in order of what held the most to what held the least.

Science – In Science, we completed our Garden Installation. We made worms, spiders, flies, ants, and also completed the flowers and leaves. We then labeled our installation. Please come and have a look at it whenever you get the chance.

English – This week, we have been looking closely at rhyming words. We read “The Cat in the Hat”, “Humpty Dumpty”, and also “Down by the Bay”. We did lots of activities using rhyming words that we learned from these different books and poems. We also wrote our very own poem about spring.

Social Studies – In Social Studies, we began learning about the continent of South America. We looked at a map and learned a few facts. We learned that South America has 12 countries and Brazil is the largest of these. We also learned that there are lots of interesting animals in South America like piranhas, anacondas, and even jaguars.

Gym – During our Gym classes this week we had an Assembly and also a rehearsal for the Spring Arts Night.

Orff – This week the Kindergarteners were in full performance-preparation mode. Both of their pieces are sounding great.

French – Students had their oral assessment this week. They were assessed on numbers, colors, greetings, fruits and vegetables. They did a good job!

Art – Students studied some of the semi-abstract decorative art of Gustav Klimt, an Austrian Painter (born in 1862, died in 1918). Specifically they looked at his swirling **Tree of Life**

decorative design, and are now in the process of creating their own mixed-media assignment based on this art work.
