Online Science Fair

Over the past month, Youth Science Canada has developed an Online Science Fair, giving all students in Grades 7 to 12 across Canada, not just those who were chosen to participate in their regional fairs, the opportunity to share their science fair projects.

This On-Line Fair opens on Monday, May 4 and students have until Monday, May 18, 2020 to complete the science fair project template provided on the website.

From May 19-27 the site will be open for all to see and some online judging will take place. Outstanding projects will have a chance to earn Toronto virtual ribbons as well as virtual ribbons awarded by Youth Science Canada and sponsors of the Canada Wide Science Fair. Projects will be judged solely on the basis of what is posted by the student. There will be no student interviews.

This is a low-level competition with no cash prizes, scholarships, or trips awarded. The focus is on showcasing the work that the youth of Canada have been doing this year in Science.

The Toronto Science Fair has emailed all Grade 7-12 students who registered for this year's cancelled fair encouraging them to participate. **However, any student in Grade 7-12 is welcome to enter this Online Science Fair.**
