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Grade One/Two Weekly Update

Language Arts Mr. Murray	Students listened to the story James and the Giant Peach, continued reviewing the letter sounds and shapes, challenged with the spelling of important sight words, performed guided reading tasks in levelled readers, looked at the use of commas in lists, and began looking at the rules of singular vs plural, as well as describing words (adjectives).
Math Mr. Murray	Students began looking at perimeter and area, and using measurement techniques to calculate perimeter of different shapes. Students also learned to identify regular and irregular polygons, and identify different angles in different shapes.
Science Mr. Murray	Students explored magnetism and made observations about different materials and their magnetic properties. Students also looked at the force of gravity, and how friction can interfere with motion.
History/Geography Mr. Murray	Students continued their unit on Ancient Civilizations by looking at The Sumerians. Students discussed the religion and lifestyle of the Sumerian culture.
Visual Arts Mme Lechallier	This week, the Grades One and Two finish working on their Chinese Art to create a Panda. Wow, so proud of the beautiful result. Great work everyone!

Grade Three Weekly Update

Language Arts Mrs. Haddad	The students continued to revise topic sentences, subjects, predicates, nouns, verbs, and adjectives. They were able to split the run- on sentences into two simple sentences and add either a subject or predicate to fragment statements to make complete sentences. Students also practised writing using simple sentences and adjectives. Great work!
Maths Ms. Sharma	This week, Grade Three continued working on symmetry of different shapes. We used different shapes to learn lines of symmetry. They also started learning about fractions, made a table of their own about different foods they eat and wrote a fraction for all of them.
Science Ms. Sharma	This week Grade Three learnt about Earthquakes and Tsunami. They learnt where to safely hide during an earthquake. They were very curious to learn about these natural disasters and watched many videos to understand the effects after real earthquakes and Tsunami.
History/Geography Ms. Carey	This week Grade Three explored places in Canada. They learned that Canada has ten provinces and three territories. They identified the ones they knew already and matched the ones they didn't know on the map. They had fun estimating how long it would take to get to each of the provinces in Canada from their house.

Language Arts Mrs. Haddad	This week, the Grade Four students examined and discussed the difference between private and public writing and information sources. Students were also able to identify and explain the difference between a biography and an autobiography.
Maths Ms. Sharma	This week Grade Four students worked on experiments and simulations for probability. They worked in groups and worked on some experiments, made a table and calculated the tally and frequency of each experiment.
Science Mrs. Haddad	For this week, the students had the opportunity to investigate the different sources of noise in their community. They thought of questions then interviewed 20 people in their community. The Grade Fours designed a table to fill in listing all the sources of noise and the people they interviewed. The students presented their data on a dot plot. They are working on writing a paragraph headed "What is being done to reduce noise in our community?" The learners enjoyed the result of the science investigation project. Students are working on presenting their results.
History/Geography Mrs. Haddad	This week the Grade Four students explained how humans have extracted utility out of mountains and their resources. Students specifically focused on describing the types of farming available to people who live on mountains. The Grade Four were encouraged to communicate the results of their inquiry using appropriate and specific vocabulary related to the topic.
