English Ms. Carey	This week in English Grade Six read an opening of a story called 'Film Boy', students predicted what they think will happen next. In doing so, students planned and wrote the next section of the story. They established a setting, they used features of spoken English and displayed a great understanding of using opening sentences to link the information into paragraphs. Students really enjoyed this activity as they love opening up their creative minds.
Math Ms. Sharma	This week Grade Six started working on the concept of collecting data. They learnt how to conduct an investigation by understanding how to categorise the data into continuous, categorical and discrete data. They discussed and gave different data based on each category to understand the concept more. They were challenged to play fraction, decimal and percentage bingo to test their understanding.
Science Ms. Sharma	This week Grade Six learnt about Energy and different sources and forms. They discussed various examples of how a form of energy can be changed into another and learnt about the ways in which energy can be stored more easily than in others. English Ms. Carey	This week in Grade Seven English, students continued working on their Shakespearean play 'Romeo and Juliet'. They focused on Act 2 Scene 3. As a class we spoke about the characteristics of both Romeo and Juliet. Students identified Romeo's actions as 'rash' as he wanted to marry Juliet so soon after meeting her and that he was just recently in love with Rosaline. Students really enjoyed discussing the actions of the characters in this scene.
Math Ms. Sharma	This week Grade Seven continued working with 3D shapes. They learnt how to draw a shapes top, front and side view. They started learning about the concept of fractions. They learnt how to calculate recurring and terminating fractions. They worked on various problems to understand the concept more.
Science Ms. Sharma	This week Grade Seven learnt about purity. They learnt how to calculate the percentage purity of gold and diamond. They learnt how diamonds are of different colours and how salt is separated from the seawater. They even were introduced to the concept of how it is difficult to get a pure product in a reaction.
History/Geography Ms. Carey	This week in Grade Seven History, students focused on rising tensions in North America between the years 1713-1755. They identified how the relationships between the First Nations, The British and The French lead to change.
