Friday, April 18, 2025

English Ms. Carey	This week in Grade Five English, students investigated the details, explored techniques and prefixes, suffixes and spelling rules. Students created a list of common suffixes and in small groups discussed spelling rules they need to use when adding them to words.
Math Ms. Sharma	This week Grade Five started working on laws of arithmetic. They worked on how to use the laws of arithmetic to simplify calculations. They worked on various examples to understand the order of operations and use brackets to change the order of operations.
Science Ms. Sharma	This week Grade Five learnt about reflection of light. They learnt how a ray of light changes direction when it is reflected from a plane mirror. They used diagrams to show how light reflects from a plane mirror and performed an activity to understand reflection using a mirror.
History/Geography Ms. Carey	This week in Grade Five History and Geography, students finished their unit of Ancient Rome. Students were divided into groups, they worked together to piece together letters that created words that originated from Ancient Rome.
